Hi

My name is Daniel,

I am here to write to the Regulatory and Government on the NBN surrounding the regulations, laws of the new NBN.

It is my view that the following should be included in the NBN.

- The New NBN must have a separate the Wholesale and RETAIL, no company owner must own either one or have any relations to it's management or CEO's, the boss, etc, etc.
- The New NBN must include updates to the network as long as it's affordable to do so.
- Maintenance must be done on new NBN as required (faults, replacing, drop in speed, no internet etc, min speed guarantied is 10/mbit sec).
- The New NBN must be under <\$70 a month RETAIL with a min of 100gig (PEAK) of quota and min of 256k shaping.
- The New NBN must have fair deals with it's wholesale customers.
- The New NBN must have fair deals between ISP's and it's customers.
- The prices of back haul, and other things must be reasonable to the ISP's...
- Schools(High School, TAFES, UNIs etc), Agency's (Such as Centerlink, Civic Solutions, Job Future Horizons, Police, Fire, Hospitals etc etc), need to be fibre based where possible.

And I Stress this now, If you give Telstra any lea-way, i will not be happy, and Also, I believe in what Simon Hacket's words is correct, and also that believe that (both old and new networks) can co-operate with each other.
